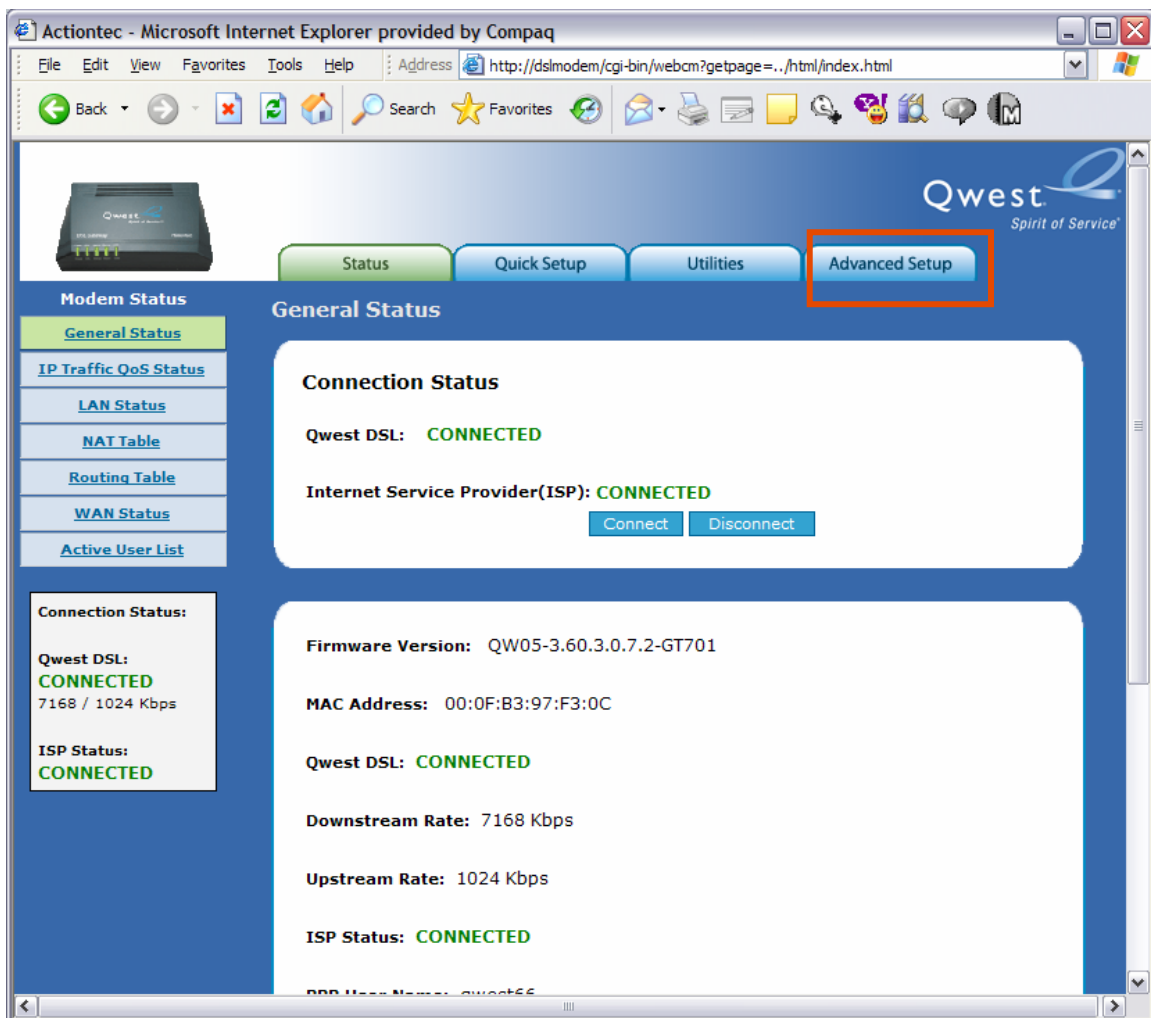


Qwest® Standard Modem: Actiontec® GT701

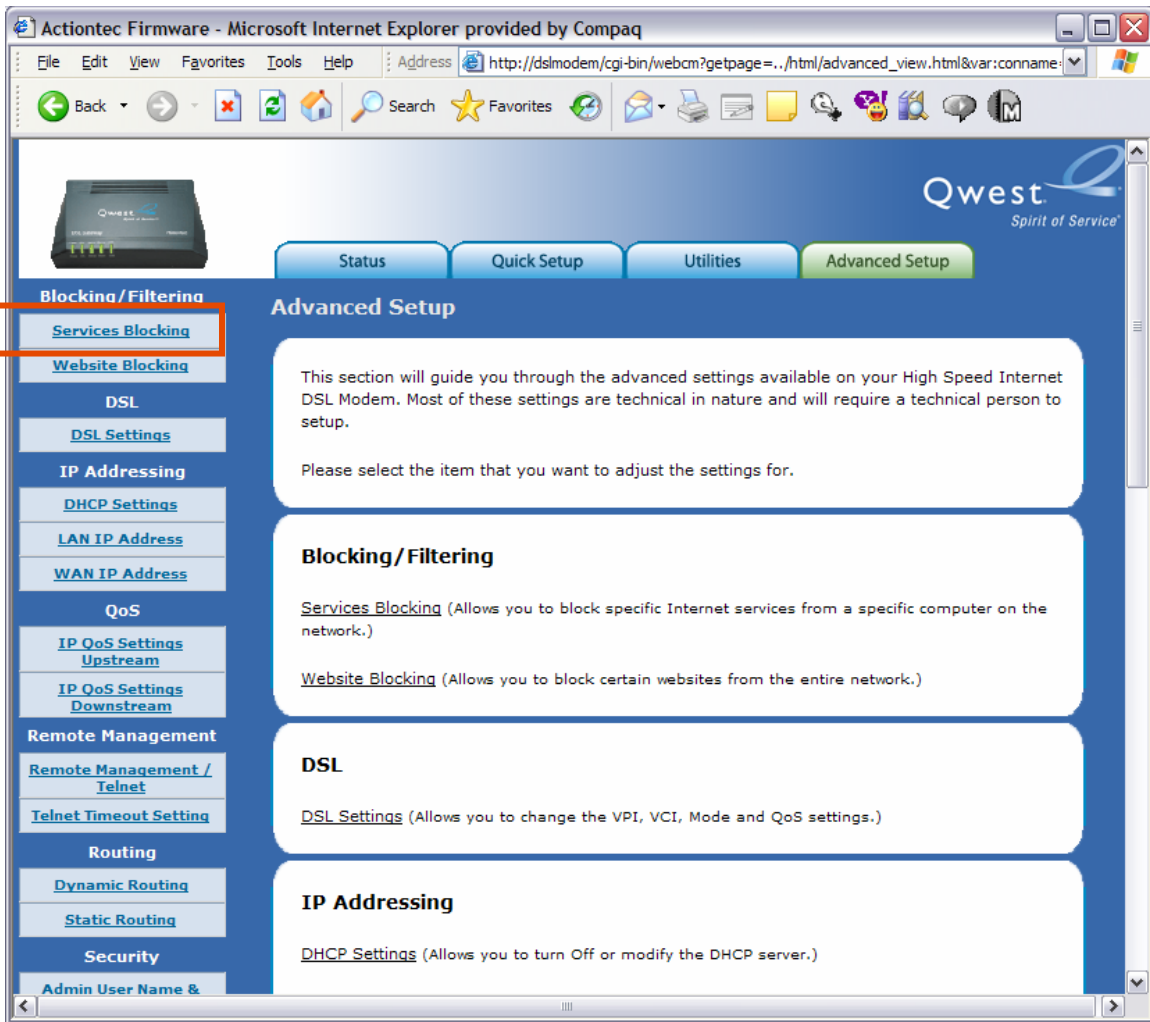
How to Enable IP Service Blocking

By enabling service blocking on your Qwest® Standard Modem: Actiontec® GT701, you can turn off selected Internet services for a specific device on the Local Area Network (LAN).

1. Enter “192.168.0.1” in the Address bar of your Internet browser, which automatically opens the “General Status” page. Select the **Advanced Setup** tab.



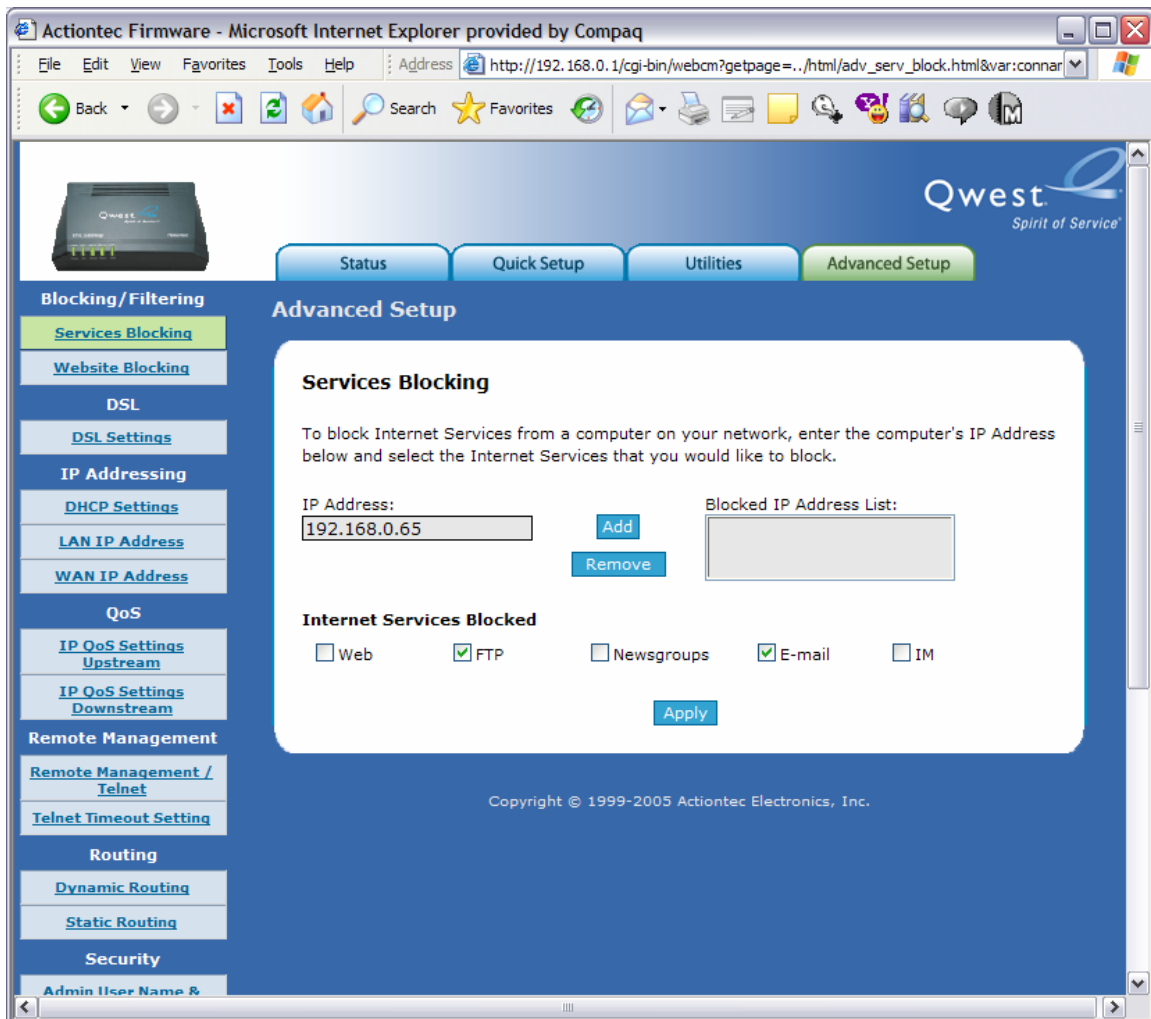
2. Select the **Services Blocking** link.



3. To block Internet services of the network device, type in the device IP address in the **IP Address** field.

In the **Internet Services Blocked** section, select the checkboxes of the service(s) to block:

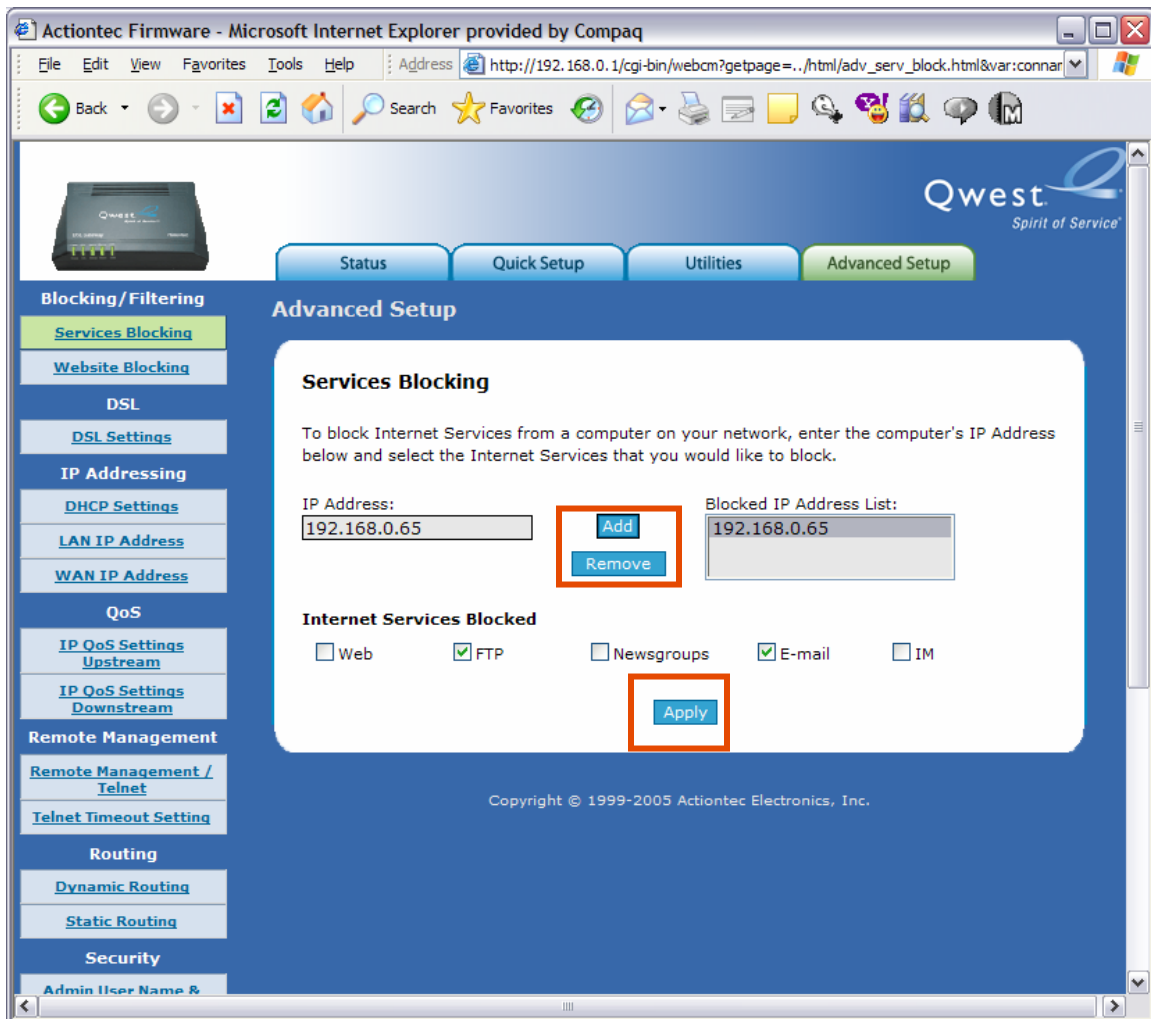
- Web
- FTP
- Newsgroups
- E-mail
- IM



4. Select the **Add** button to add the device to the **Blocked IP Address List** field.

To remove IP restrictions, select the device IP address in the **Blocked IP Address List** field. Select the **Remove** button.

Then, select **Apply** to save your settings.



5. A “Thank You” page appears briefly. After configuration is complete, you’re automatically redirected to the “Services Blocking” page.
